Foreword

Astrology is a universal language. It reveals inner dynamics, creative tensions, potentials to be developed and thresholds to be crossed. It accompanies us in our quest for meaning and unity. We meet creative geniuses like Leonardo da Vinci, Mozart, William Blake, Frida Kahlo and Steve Jobs; sages and guides like the Dalai Lama, Mother Teresa, Saint Francis of Assisi, Maria Montessori, Pierre Teilhard de Chardin and Swami Kriyananda. Pioneers of thought such as Carl Jung, Sigmund Freud, Spinoza, Emmanuel Kant, Françoise Dolto and Edgar Morin. Visionary writers such as Victor Hugo, Dostoyevsky, Proust, Rousseau, Maupassant, Jules Verne and Petrarch.

This journey also includes political and historical figures with contrasting destinies, such as Napoleon Bonaparte, Margaret Thatcher, Willy Brandt, Nelson Mandela, Robert

Badinter and Lech Walesa. There are icons of the stage like Angelina Jolie, Emma Watson, Lady Gaga, Jennifer Lopez, Johnny Cash, Madonna, Keanu Reeves and Jim Carrey, alongside committed voices like Jamel Debbouze, Manu Chao and Shakira

Each portrait is presented in an astrological light that is both educational and respectful. The aim here is not to 'categorise' people, but to explore how certain astrological configurations are reflected in commitments, lifestyles, wounds overcome, creative impulses and paths of transformation.

This book is neither a dictionary nor a static gallery, but a lively exploration of the human psyche through the prism of the natal sky. Its aim is to provide the reader with keys to understanding the resonances between the great figures of our time (and of other times) and the universal archetypes that inhabit us all.

I hope that this reading will open you up to the richness of astrology as a tool for awareness, compassion and discovery. May these celebrities inspire you, not by their fame, but by the reflections they can offer to your own quest for inner unity.

Introduction

The stars have fascinated us for thousands of years. Not because they exert a mechanical influence on our lives, but because they subtly synchronise with what we experience, feel and seek to understand. Astrology, far from being a fixed belief system, is above all a symbolic language. It offers landmarks, points of reference, a poetic, lucid and profound way of looking at the human experience.

In this book, I wanted to illustrate the richness of this language by relating it to the lives of people who are well known to the general public. Celebrities - be they artists, thinkers, humanitarians, explorers or historical figures - offer a valuable field of observation. Not because their fame makes them superior or 'more evolved', but because it makes their lives visible. Their lives, in part exposed, shed light on certain astrological dynamics with a clarity that would be more difficult to perceive in an anonymous life.

In these portraits, it is never a question of reducing a person to his or her natal chart, or claiming to explain his or her existence by a planetary alignment. My intention is rather to show how the great archetypes of astrology - the signs, the houses, the aspects between planets - can find various resonances in concrete life paths.

In this way, the same astrological aspect can be expressed in a thousand different ways: in one case, as a driving force for social commitment; in another, as creative energy or a spiritual calling. The natal chart does not tell *us who we*

are in a definitive way; it sketches out dynamics and sheds light on possibilities. It never locks us in: it invites awareness.

Robert Badinter

Robert Badinter was Minister of Justice, lawyer and campaigner for the abolition of the death penalty. With an astrological configuration of a Sun in Aries in the 12th House and an Ascendant in Aries, Badinter perfectly embodied the archetype of the altruistic warrior, using his audacity and determination for the collective good, particularly in his fight to abolish the death penalty in France. His career and commitment reflect the fusion between the energy of Aries, oriented towards action and change, and the profound themes of the 12th House, linked to altruism, sacrifice and universal causes. Like a true pioneer (Aries), Badinter sensed and acted on the social movements of his time with visionary clarity. His fight to abolish the death penalty was ahead of its time, responding to a collective call for a more humane and just society. House 12 evokes selfless service and hidden struggles. Badinter worked tirelessly, often far from the spotlight, to mobilise support and change mentalities, not for his own personal glory, but to transform French society on a deeply controversial subject. Johann Sebastian Bach

Emmanuel Kant

Emmanuel Kant, German philosopher, founder of the Critique of Pure Reason and a pillar of Western philosophy, had his Sun in Taurus in House 12 and his Ascendant also in Taurus. This configuration, particularly in the 12th house, evokes a person who was strongly anchored in his principles and values, but who was also confronted with themes of sacrifice, introspection and service. Kant was determined to remain in his native region while devoting himself to vast intellectual explorations.

The presence of Mercury and the Moon in Aries in the 12th house reinforces the idea of a lively and curious mind, ready to engage in bold and original thinking. This constellation indicates a revolutionary thought that, although generated in the private setting of his home, had a worldwide impact. The square with Saturn and Mars, the context Taurus and Mars in Cancer in the 4th house, underlines the challenges and restrictions Kant may have felt in his personal life, perhaps reflecting his decision never to leave his native region, despite a global awareness and curiosity.

The dynamic between calm Taurus and bold Aries, as well as the challenges posed by the square aspects, reflects the duality in Kant's life and work. Despite an apparently sedentary existence (Taurus), his mind (Mercury in Aries) never stopped travelling through ideas, making a significant contribution to modern philosophy.

His commitment to social and ethical issues, and his ability to welcome new and diverse perspectives (Moon in Aries in house 12 and opposition of Uranus to the Sun), while remaining deeply rooted in his community (Sun in Taurus, Mars in Cancer in house 4), illustrate how he was able to use his limited living space as an advantage to deepen his philosophical reflections.

Pierre Teilhard de Chardin

Pierre Teilhard de Chardin, French priest, scientist and philosopher, a pioneer of thought integrating science and spirituality, had his Sun in Taurus in the 12th House and a

Gemini Ascendant. The Sun in Taurus brings a foundation of stability, perseverance and a deep connection with the material world. In the 12th House, this energy turns inwards, suggesting a life of inner contemplation and a quest for meaning that goes beyond outward appearances. For Teilhard de Chardin, this manifested itself in his deep commitment to his studies and research, seeking to understand the mysteries of the universe and the human condition. His Gemini Ascendant reveals a personality that was curious, adaptable and eternally in search of knowledge. This astrological configuration underlines his multidisciplinary approach, his desire to communicate his ideas and to connect different fields of knowledge, from theology to palaeontology and philosophy. Teilhard de Chardin was known for his ability to weave links between science and spirituality, an approach that reflects the agility and versatility of Gemini. The 12th House, often associated with isolation, spirituality and hidden trials, indicates an important part of Teilhard de Chardin's life devoted to meditation and solitary reflection. His writings, imbued with a profound spirituality, show how he used these periods of isolation to develop his cosmic vision of evolution and of Christ as the omega point, unifying spirit and matter. Although his Sun in the 12th House suggests a somewhat withdrawn nature, his Gemini Ascendant enabled him to communicate his complex ideas in an accessible way. Françoise Dolto

Françoise Dolto, French paediatrician and psychoanalyst, is a pioneer in the understanding of children. Jonas Salk is an eloquent example of the Scorpio archetype on a journey of discovery, transformation and profound healing, not only for himself but for humanity. This position emphasises an introspective nature, with an inclination to explore the hidden aspects of life and oneself. Alexandra David-Neel

Alexandra David-Néel, French explorer, writer and Orientalist, is famous for being the first Western woman to visit Lhasa, Tibet, disguised as a pilgrim, and for her books on Buddhism and Oriental spirituality. With her Sun in Scorpio in the 1st house and Ascendant in Libra, she represents a personality deeply drawn to the quest for balance and harmony in relationships, while at the same time being driven by an ardent passion for exploring the mysteries of life. This astrological combination was the driving force behind her legendary journey to Tibet. Her most famous journey was her visit to Lhasa, Tibet, in 1924, disguised as a beggar woman. This journey, made at a time when it was forbidden for foreigners to enter the

holy city, made her the first Western woman known to have entered it.

Her adventure in Tibet, where she met yogis, lamas and other spiritual figures, perfectly reflected the balance between her need for deep, intimate knowledge (Scorpio) and her aspiration for universal peace and understanding (Libra). Her interactions with these spiritual masters, often described in her writings², show how she used her charisma and intellect (traits of the Ascendant Libra) to navigate a world that was both foreign and fascinating, while at the same time engaging in a personal quest for transformation and revelation (traits of the Sun in Scorpio).

Her decision to embark on such a journey, marked by considerable challenges and encounters with the mystical, demonstrates the strength of Scorpio within her: a willingness to plunge into the unknown and confront the deepest and sometimes darkest aspects of existence. At the same time, her Ascendant in Libra has enabled her to approach these experiences with an open mind and an ability to make meaningful connections with the people she meets, always seeking balance and harmony, even in the most extreme conditions.

Niccolò Paganini

Niccolò Paganini, the 19th-century Italian violin virtuoso and composer, legendary for his technique, is a perfect example of the astrological combination of a Sun in Scorpio in 10th house with an Ascendant in Sagittarius.
