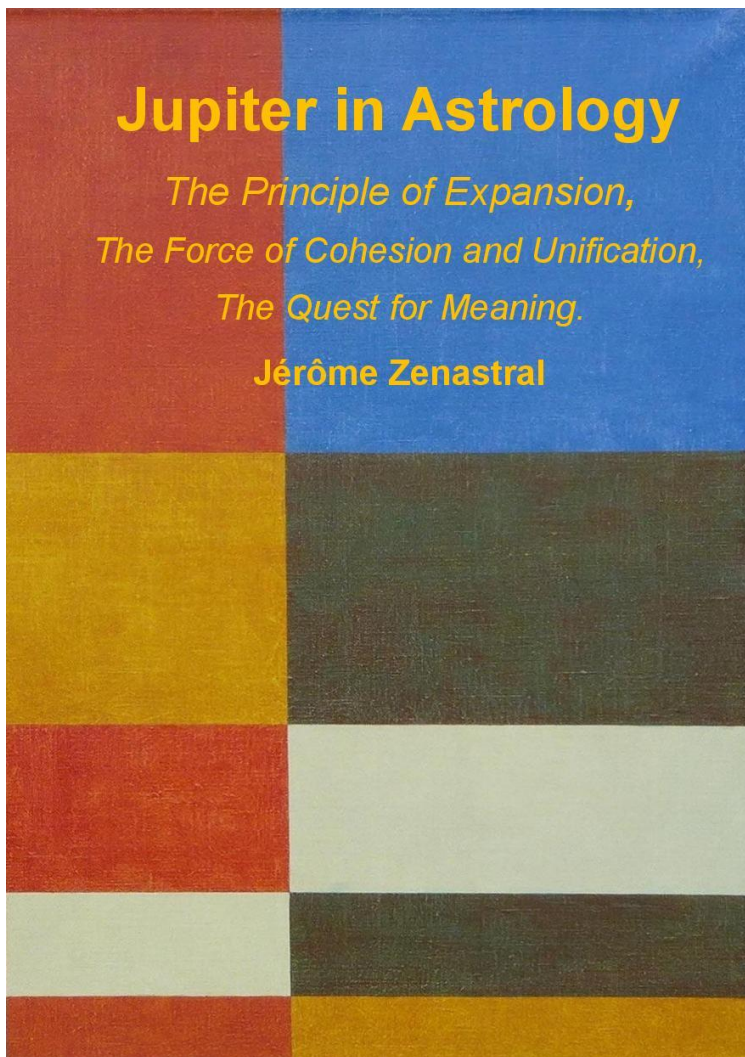

Preface

For nearly fifty years now, I have walked with astrology as one walks with a sacred art: with respect, with high standards, with wonder. Book after book, I have tried to share what I have been given to understand and experience, so that everyone can make this tool for inner exploration their own, rather than simply receiving ready-made answers. From *Astrology and Mindfulness* to *Mercury in Astrology*, via *Aspects in Astrology* and *The Nodes of the Moon*, my intention has remained the same: to help you read your own natal chart, not as a fixed destiny, but as a living, subtle language that reflects your own inner movement.

This book is part of that continuity. It is devoted to Jupiter, principle of expansion, force of cohesion and pillar of moral life. Wherever Jupiter is found in a natal chart, something within us aspires to grow, to connect, to understand. It is the part of us that seeks to give meaning, to weave the links between the individual and the world, between intimate aspirations and the wider laws that transcend us.

Through the 144 combinations formed by Jupiter in the 12 signs of the zodiac and the 12 astrological houses, I have tried to capture the diversity of possible expressions of this inner dimension. Each of these configurations reveals a unique way of growing, believing and hoping, of opening up a space within ourselves to welcome life in all its complexity and depth.

But I felt it essential to go further. Jupiter never exists alone in a chart: it is in constant relationship with the other planets. These aspects - conjunctions, squares, trigons, oppositions... - form an invisible but essential framework. They tell the story of the tensions, harmonies, challenges and promises we witness. This is why a third key to interpretation is proposed here: that of aspects to Jupiter. These aspects reflect the dynamic interference between different psychic forces, adding an extra layer of complexity to the way in which this dynamic of growth is expressed. Aspects of relaxation encourage harmony and fluidity, while aspects of tension invite us to become aware of, integrate and overcome the inner conflicts linked to our quest for meaning.

As in all my books, I invite you to approach this reading with an inner eye. Not to look for verdicts, but for resonances. To listen to what enters into dialogue within you with the symbols. Because astrology, as I see it, is not based on the influence of the stars, but on synchronicity. I believe that there is no direct influence of the stars on our destiny, but rather a symbolic parallelism between the celestial structure at the moment of our birth and our psyche. This approach excludes all astral causality and invites us to see astrology as a symbolic language, a mirror that gives us a better grasp of our inner dynamics, our potential and our dark areas.

Whether you're an astrology enthusiast or a curious person in search of meaning, *Jupiter in Astrology* will help you to become more aware of your astrological heritage, and to discover how this energy can become a source of strength, clarity and transformation for you.

It is with this in mind that I invite you to explore the following pages, so that Jupiter is no longer just a planet in a chart, but a gateway to a wider, more vibrant knowledge of yourself.

Introduction

Jupiter represents an inner drive towards expansion, but this expansion is not material in the crude sense; it is moral, intellectual, existential. The part of us that seeks growth is the part that aspires to a more coherent, more encompassing order, to a broader understanding of the world. This is not an egotistical desire to be more, but a natural tendency of consciousness to open up, to connect, to integrate. It is the movement by which the individual leaves behind a strictly personal vision to become part of something wider: a group, a culture, a vision of the world, a meaning. We could say that it's the drive for meaning that pushes us to link the elements, to structure them into a more unified, more encompassing vision - where Mercury sorts and analyses, Jupiter brings together and gives coherence.

This need for inner growth stems from a yearning for unity and meaning. Human consciousness cannot be satisfied with surviving or repeating: it seeks to understand, to connect, to rise above immediacy to see further, higher. It's a movement to go beyond, not by refusing what is, but by moving towards what gives meaning to what is.

Saturn, opposite, limits. He confronts Jupiter with reality, forcing him to integrate his aspirations into a framework. But without Jupiter, there would be no vision, no horizon, no moral direction. In a way, he embodies the call of the soul towards that which is beyond it, a force of cohesion that wants to unite the parts into a coherent, fruitful, supportive whole.

In other words, Jupiter is in us what wants to connect, integrate, optimise, order in a broader sense, where other psychic functions divide, define or protect. This is what drives growth: the inner quest for a wider order, a fuller integration, at once personal, social and sometimes spiritual. It's an evolving force, but not in the sense of becoming "better", but rather in the sense of becoming part of something larger than oneself, in a world that's ordered, alive and full of laws.

In a theme, Jupiter doesn't just indicate a tendency or a disposition: it traces an inner direction, a possible path of growth. Jupiter's position in a sign reveals the qualities to be cultivated, the attitudes to be strengthened, the types of energy to be invested to respond to this need for enlargement and coherence. In other words, the sign Jupiter occupies shows how this force of expansion can be concretely embodied in an individual's life: what virtues to support, what impulses to nurture, what relationship to the world to encourage so that inner growth takes place in the right direction. Developing the qualities of the sign in which Jupiter is found means serving this drive for meaning, this desire for unity, and becoming more consciously involved in a dynamic of personal and collective cohesion.

The house in which Jupiter is found indicates the area of life where this growth can manifest itself more naturally, where the impulse for inner expansion seeks to express itself, to take shape, to find fertile ground. This is an area where we feel the need to expand our points of reference, to give meaning, to integrate a dimension wider than

ourselves. This area of life becomes a place of learning, of openness, of confidence, sometimes even of luck, as long as you invest in it with sincerity. Jupiter's house thus shows where you are invited to evolve, to experience cohesion and meaning, by developing a broader, more generous or more enlightened vision of yourself and the world.

Your Jupiter is in the sign of Aries

With Jupiter in Aries, your need to connect with something greater than yourself comes through direct affirmation of who you are, through the boldness to initiate, decide and act. Your power to expand - this inner desire to unfold, to understand, to open up to the world - is expressed in momentum, initiative, the ability to commit yourself without waiting for the approval of the group. You seek meaning by moving forward, by daring, by facing life head-on. You don't care about following the rules: what lifts you up is the conviction that your personal drive is immediately coherent and right. You find your place in the collective not by submitting to it, but by embodying a pioneering force that opens up new paths. You blossom by affirming what drives you, and it's by remaining faithful to this impulse that a larger, more vibrant world can be born.

Your Jupiter is in Aries, in the 1st house

With Jupiter in Aries in the 1st house, your presence in the world is directly inhabited by a drive for growth and inner conquest, a living force that pushes you to assert yourself boldly and initiate your own path. You are invited to grow by committing yourself fully to who you are, without waiting for external authorisation, by daring to present yourself as you feel authentically, carried along by a natural confidence in your impulses. Your personal development comes from spontaneous action, direct experience, and the intuitive certainty that your movement, even if it upsets, is right and meaningful. You're not content just to be in the world: you move

through it with the flame of someone who explores, discovers, opens passages, embodying a generous and foundational vision that feeds on your own fire. It's not by stepping aside that you find your place, but by letting who you are shine through with openness and enthusiasm, in a form of simple, inspiring affirmation, where your very identity becomes a vector of meaning and expansion.

Your Jupiter is in Aries, in the 2nd house.

With Jupiter in Aries in the 2nd house, your desire for inner expansion involves a direct affirmation of your resources, talents and values, as if your security were rooted in the ability to dare to put into practice what drives you deeply. You are invited to develop an active and confident relationship with what you possess, not to accumulate, but to bring to fruition what is alive and fertile within you. You move forward by creating, initiating and committing yourself to projects where your sense of action is combined with a need to build something tangible and lasting, in your own image. Your relationship with money and materials becomes more accurate when you remain faithful to the impulse that runs through you, the impulse that drives you to give shape to your ideas without waiting for the approval of others. It's by investing with faith in what you consider essential that you open yourself up to a form of abundance, where value is born of the coherence between who you are and what you choose to bring to life.

Your Jupiter is in Aries, in the 3rd house

With Jupiter in Aries in the 3rd house, your desire to expand involves speaking out vividly and directly, driven by the urgency to say what you feel, to share what you discover as you move forward. You don't wait for the world to invite you to speak or to learn: you take the initiative in dialogue, understanding and connection, by engaging fully in exchanges with those around you. Every conversation, every reading, every journey becomes an opportunity for you to assert yourself, to chart your own intellectual course, to put into words what drives you with spontaneous force. Your mind thrives on movement, on the active exploration of ideas and points of view, as long as they nourish your quest for coherence and inner truth. You have the gift of injecting new energy into everyday exchanges, awakening in others a taste for clarity, frankness and the audacity to think for yourself.

Your Jupiter is in Aries, in the 4th house

Your Jupiter is in Aries, in the 5th house

Your Jupiter is in Aries, in the 9th house.

With Jupiter in Aries in the 9th house, your quest for meaning is animated by an irresistible drive towards the elsewhere, the unknown, the open, and it's through action, initiative and the courage to explore that you connect with a wider dimension of existence. You seek less to adopt a system of thought than to experience it in motion, in direct experience, in the act of setting out, of daring, of crossing boundaries - whether physical, mental or spiritual. You move towards knowledge as you would embark on an adventure: enthusiastically, without waiting for authorisation, carried along by a spontaneous confidence in the rightness of your impulse. Philosophy, faith and wisdom are alive and well for you only if they resonate with your need for commitment, daring and freedom. You don't just learn, you initiate, you open up paths, you pass on what you yourself have experienced as a pioneer. If Neptune is in a tension aspect to your Jupiter:

If Uranus is in a tension aspect to your Jupiter:

If Saturn is in a tension aspect to your Jupiter:

If Mars is in a tension aspect to your Jupiter:

This aspect brings into play two inner tendencies: the force of cohesion and vision (Jupiter) and the force of affirmation and action (Mars). When these are not in balance, tensions can arise.

When the Jupiterian force gains the upper hand over the Martian force, you avoid direct confrontation. You find it difficult to act within the framework imposed by society or to follow collective rules. Convinced that you hold a higher truth, you think you know what's right for everyone. If Mercury is in a tension aspect to your Jupiter:

This aspect brings together two tendencies in your psyche: cohesive strength (Jupiter) and mental strength (Mercury). When they come into conflict, this can cause the following imbalances:

If the Mercury force takes precedence over the Jupiter force, you may reject any form of rule or framework. You easily deride what others consider to be serious or structuring. You disregard social conventions and have

trouble assessing the real importance of things. Distracted or flippant, you sometimes lack discernment and make errors of judgement.

If the Jupiterian force dominates the Mercurian force, you tend to remain locked into what you already know, without seeking to explore other points of view. You attach more importance to concrete benefits than to intellectual discovery. Your opinions become rigid, and you refuse to question your beliefs or reasoning, even when they lack foundation.



Personal development:

- Know how to be measured in what you communicate and only make promises when you are certain you can keep your commitments.
- Apply your intellectual faculties and make the most of things.

If Venus is in a tension aspect to your Jupiter:

This aspect brings into play two inner tendencies: the force of expansion and cohesion (Jupiter) and the force of emotional attraction (Venus). When these are out of balance, tensions can arise in the way you love and relate to others.

If the Venusian force takes precedence over the Jupiterian force, you'll seek pleasure and immediate gratification above all . Attracted by pleasurable emotions, you may multiply relationships or seduce without really taking into

account rules, commitments or consequences. The desire to please sometimes gets the better of your sense of responsibility.

If the Jupiterian force dominates to the detriment of the Venusian force, you tend to relegate your emotional impulses to the background. Your need for recognition, success or adherence to social norms can lead you to neglect your love life. You prefer to focus on what seems to make you grow or make you feel valued, to the detriment of listening to your deepest desires.

Harmonious aspects to your Jupiter

If Pluto is in a relaxed aspect to your Jupiter:
