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Preface

This book offers an in-depth exploration of the richness of Venus in astrology, a fundamental symbol of our power of seduction and our strength of attraction. Venus reveals the unique way in which we love, seduce and seek harmony in our emotional and social relationships.

You will discover the interpretation of the 144 combinations formed by Venus in the 12 signs of the zodiac and the 12 astrological houses. Each combination unfolds a specific nuance, revealing our emotions, desires and ways of interacting with others. Through this work, it becomes possible to better understand our deep emotional needs and modes of expression.

Beyond this dual interpretation of signs and houses, the book also includes an analysis of the aspects that Venus forms with other planets. These aspects reflect dynamic interactions between different psychic forces, adding further complexity to the way we express our charm and our ability to form bonds. Aspects of relaxation promote harmony and fluidity, while aspects of tension invite awareness, integration and the overcoming of inner conflicts related to love.

To understand these configurations, it is important to keep in mind my personal view of astrology, based on the principle of synchronicity. I believe that there is no direct influence of the stars on our destiny, but rather a symbolic parallel between the celestial structure at the moment of our birth and our psyche. This approach excludes any

astral causality and invites us to see astrology as a symbolic language, a mirror that allows us to better understand our inner dynamics, our potentialities, and our shadow areas.

It is with this interpretation that I invite you to explore the following pages, so that Venus is no longer just a planet in a chart, but a path to a better understanding of yourself and a conscious celebration of your power of attraction.

Introduction

In astrology, Venus symbolises the force of attraction that unites us with others. This attraction works according to a principle of affinity, revealing that the people we are attracted to or with whom we develop bonds often fulfil a need for tenderness and love. Venus thus embodies the desire to seduce and connect emotionally, seeking to express the best of oneself through these interactions.

The position of Venus in a sign shows the intuitive way in which we approach love and seduction. Furthermore, the astrological house in which Venus is located reveals the area of our life where we seek to seduce and flourish emotionally. By understanding this dynamic, we gain a clearer insight into our emotional needs and the areas where we find the greatest emotional and relational fulfilment.

Your Venus is in Aries

Dissonant aspects to your Venus in Aries

Your Venus is in Taurus

If your Venus is in Taurus in the 1st House:

With Venus in Taurus in the 1st House, your way of loving is deeply rooted in sensations, stability and embodiment, and this quality radiates directly through your presence. You exude an aura of quiet gentleness, a natural and soothing charm that attracts effortlessly. In love, as in your interactions, you value sincerity, consistency and the pleasure of simple things. If your Venus is in Taurus in the 2nd house:

It is difficult for you to separate emotional attachment from a certain material well-being, as if love needs a tangible foundation to flourish fully. You like to own things of value – objects, relationships, experiences – but even more than that, you like to take care of them and make them last. Your natural sensuality is also expressed in your taste for beauty, your physical approach to life, and your ability to form nourishing bonds through exchanges, even financial ones. Be careful, however, not to confuse possession with security: what you cherish benefits from remaining free. If your Venus is in Taurus in the 3rd House:

If your Venus is in Taurus in the 6th house:
