Workshop 2 Examples of interpreting astrological themes

This workshop brings together several examples of astrological interpretations carried out according to the approach proposed by this school: a lively, symbolic and conscious reading of the natal chart, where each element is considered as an energy to be integrated, rather than a simple fixed character trait.

The examples presented here are not models to be copied, but sources of inspiration. They will help you to:

- Observe how the symbols interact with each other (planets, signs, houses, aspects),
- Grasp the spirit of living interpretation, which goes beyond technical definitions,
- Develop your own intuitive sensitivity by listening to what the chart is telling you on a deeper level,
- Gain confidence in your ability to interpret, based on concrete examples.

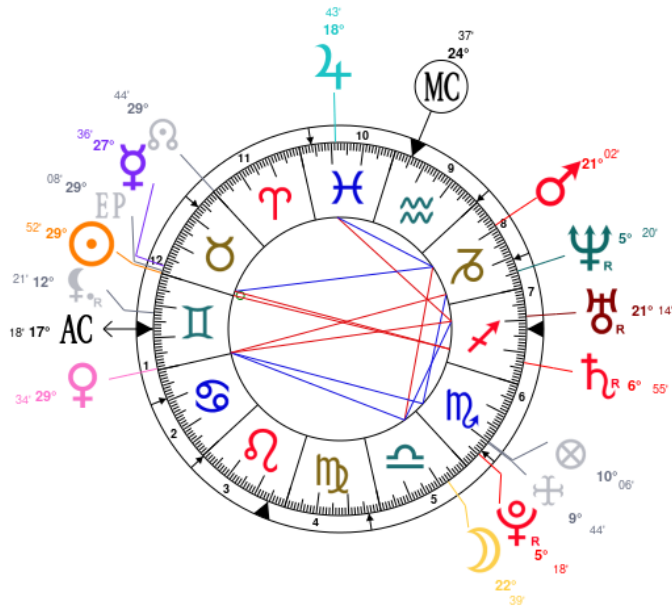
How to use these examples to progress:

- Read one example at a time, with a clear head, and take the time to identify the elements that have been linked.
- Before reading the interpretation, first look at the chart yourself (if you have it in front of you) and ask yourself: *What do I feel when I look at this chart?*

- Write down your own impressions, then compare them to the suggested interpretation. This will help you to compare your spontaneous reading with a developed analysis, without judgement.
- Reread certain passages with the manuals or previous lessons to hand: you will be able to see how the concepts studied translate into a real chart.
- Finally, try to make your own complete interpretations of other birth charts, drawing inspiration from the structure or tone of the examples provided here.

Over time, you will find that your approach becomes more fluid, more intuitive, and above all more personal. Astrological interpretation is a living art that develops through practice, listening, and inner resonance.

1) Study of Emma's astrological chart



Emma, you are a lively and approachable woman, marked by a Gemini Ascendant that makes you curious, adaptable, always reaching out to others, eager to connect and share. Yet behind this apparent lightness lies a much greater depth: your Sun in Taurus, in the 12th house, conjunct Mercury, ruler of your Ascendant, reveals an introverted, contemplative, almost mystical nature. You carry within you a discreet but radiant light, a rare ability to devote yourself, to serve, to silently offer your inner stability to the collective or to those you love. You think deeply, slowly, with a wisdom rooted in feeling rather than pure intellect. There is a fruitful tension within you between the need to communicate and the need to withdraw, between

the call of the world and the demand for a sacred relationship with existence. Finding a space where you can exchange ideas while remaining true to your inner self is essential to your balance. Your strength does not lie in visibility, but in the consistency with which you hold your ground, quietly, in service to something greater than yourself.

With your Moon in Libra in the 5th house, Emma, you are a woman who is deeply sensitive to the beauty of connections, the elegance of form, and the grace of gestures and words, especially in the emotional, creative, and educational realms. You naturally seek to create harmony around you, especially in your romantic relationships or with children, and you have an innate talent for conveying gentleness, listening skills and a sense of justice. Your way of loving is refined and delicate, guided by the ideal of a balanced, reciprocal love made up of subtle seduction and mutual respect. This lunar placement is magnified by a trine to Venus in Gemini, which accentuates your natural charm and ease in communication and gives you a sure taste for aesthetic pleasures, light-hearted encounters and playful dialogue. Added to this is a sextile from Uranus, which infuses your sensitivity with a touch of originality, openness and freedom: you need to feel free in your emotions and to maintain a space for movement in your relationships and creative impulses. However, this beautiful structure is crossed by an inner tension, that of the square to Mars in Capricorn in the 8th house, which reveals a struggle between your desire for harmony and a more subterranean, combative force rooted in survival or protective instincts.

You may experience bouts of impatience or even anger that you don't always understand, as they contradict your deep desire for peace. However, these rougher impulses are part of who you are; they teach you to set boundaries and assert yourself without denying your sensitivity. Your challenge is to unite these two poles: grace and firmness, gentleness and lucidity, to turn your emotions into a force of full, lively and free expression.

Emma, with Mars in Capricorn in the 8th house, you carry a powerful, focused energy, oriented towards mastering the deep and sometimes troubling areas of existence. You approach the challenges of intimate life, committed relationships, shared money and inner transformations with a mixture of composure, patience and tenacity. You never act lightly, and your way of loving or fighting often involves silence and measured gestures, but these are imbued with real intensity. Your strength lies in your ability to weather crises without collapsing, to rebuild what is falling apart around you with almost stoic perseverance. But this deep commitment comes into tension with your Moon in Libra in the 5th house, which aspires to gentleness, harmony and the pleasure of loving without stakes or power struggles. This square reveals a tension between your emotional needs – for tenderness, beauty and lightness – and a darker or more demanding side of yourself, which pushes you to excel, to control, to commit fully even at the cost of conflict or tension. This can result in difficulty relaxing fully in your relationships or expressing your emotional needs in a fluid way. You may tend to impose excessive restraint or control on yourself, or even stifle your spontaneous impulses.

However, this conflict is also an invitation to unite two valuable forces within you: the grace of the heart and the rigour of the soul. It is not a question of choosing between sensitivity and strength, but of learning to bring them into dialogue with each other. You will benefit from listening to your need for beauty and lightness without giving up your depth, honouring your emotions without fear of losing control, and letting love flow freely even in the midst of the most intimate transformations.

Emma, with Venus in Gemini in the 1st House, you radiate a spontaneous, light, lively charm that captures attention with your words, humour and intelligent gaze. Your way of relating to others is joyful, curious and playful, reflecting a genuine inner liveliness. You need interaction to love, that flexible and free flow between hearts and minds, where encounters become games, dances and explorations. You seduce not only with your outer beauty, but also with your lively presence, your mobility, and your ability to establish natural, relaxed connections, often tinged with mischief. However, this beautiful lightness is put under tension by the opposition of Uranus in Sagittarius in the 7th House, which introduces a more unpredictable, sometimes chaotic, but always deeply free dimension into your emotional life. You are instinctively resistant to anything that resembles emotional constraint: you can love intensely but flee as soon as you feel trapped, or you can spark exciting but unstable relationships. There is a call within you for free, unconventional, evolving love, and this can create tension between your need for connection and your need for space. This opposition also evokes a polarity between the seductive, free, playful self

(House 1) and the other, who brings otherness, commitment and difference (House 7). You are thus invited to reconcile your aspiration for independence with your deep need for authentic connection. You can never love under duress, but you can love consciously, redefining commitment in your own way: as a pact of shared freedom, mutual respect and common growth. The more you embrace your airy, changeable and inventive nature, while listening to the sincere beating of your heart, the more your relationships will become living, invigorating and deeply nourishing spaces for growth.

Emma, your Venus in Gemini in the 1st House, already so lively, spontaneous, curious and radiant, is currently entering a particularly significant period in terms of relationships, aesthetics and identity. Right now, Jupiter is transiting your natal Venus, and this is acting as a beneficial amplification of your natural qualities: your magnetism, your taste for connection, and your pleasure in being in relationships are being highlighted, sometimes even in a striking way. This transit can offer you emotional, social or creative opportunities, fruitful encounters, renewed confidence in your power of attraction or a chance to assert yourself in the way you love and connect with others.

But at the same time, Saturn and Neptune are transiting Aries, forming a square to this same Venus, which introduces a more subtle and demanding tension. Saturn, on the one hand, pushes you to mature in your way of loving and to become aware of certain limitations or illusions in your relationships. It may confront you with more concrete expectations, the need to set fairer

boundaries, or even a fruitful solitude that refocuses you on what is essential. Neptune, on the other hand, dissolves anything that is not aligned with your inner truth, which can sometimes create confusion, a form of disillusionment, but also a great openness to a more inspired, compassionate vision of love and connection.

This trio of transits therefore acts as a major emotional and relational readjustment: Jupiter pushes you to open up, to dare more, to shine with confidence — while Saturn and Neptune ask you not to spread yourself too thin, to remain true to yourself, and not to confuse freedom with escape, or playfulness with superficiality. This can be an extremely fruitful time if you dance with these opposing forces: welcoming what opens up with enthusiasm, while remaining attentive to what is fading away, to what no longer has a place. This is not the time to force a direction, but rather to listen to the movements of life, to feel when the wave is carrying you... and when it is better to wait for the next current. Your ability to adjust with flexibility, clarity and authenticity will be your best guide in this period of transformation and expansion.

Emma, with Uranus in Sagittarius in the 7th house, you carry within you a deep call for freedom in your relationships with others, which can sometimes come into tension with your sincere desire for harmony and union, as expressed through your Moon in Libra in the 5th house. This Moon reveals a part of you that is deeply attached to the beauty of connection, the sweetness of emotional intimacy, and peaceful, warm reciprocity. You aspire to be

loved in an atmosphere of balance, respect, and emotional elegance.

Added to this is your Venus in Gemini in the 1st house, which colours your way of loving with curiosity, liveliness and lightness. You charm naturally with your words, your wit and your subtle listening skills. You need lively exchanges and a connection that remains fluid, stimulating and free of any heaviness. For you, love often begins with a meeting of minds, a playful complicity, a spontaneous connection.

But your Uranus in Sagittarius, placed in the 7th house, invites you to embark on another adventure: that of free authenticity in relationships. It pushes you not to settle for reassuring or simply harmonious connections. It calls you to experiment with relationships outside the established norms, which respect your fundamental need for inner truth, independence, and personal growth. It draws you to partners who are original, different, sometimes foreign in the broadest sense—culturally, philosophically, or spiritually—and regularly awakens you when a relationship becomes too predictable or stagnant.

This Uranus in Sagittarius asks you to re-examine your beliefs about couples and to question what you think you ‘should be’ in a relationship. It opens you up to the possibility of reinventing the way you love and commit, in accordance with your own ever-evolving worldview.

Its location in the 7th house, the domain of partnerships, intensifies these issues. It is likely that certain crises or

breakups have been, or are, necessary steps to free you from conditioning and allow you to dare to enter into a relationship based on awareness rather than habit.

And this is all the more significant given that Mars in Capricorn in the 8th house, square your Moon, indicates that these transformations are not insignificant. You experience intimate relationships with intensity, high standards, and sometimes with a need for control or mastery in the face of deep fears. Your energy for action is engaged in the most complex dimensions of relationships: crises, sexuality, issues of power, trust, and transformation.

The square between Mars and the Moon shows an inner conflict between your emotional sensitivity, which seeks harmony, and your way of acting, which is colder, more determined, and sometimes uncompromising in moments of tension. You may feel torn between the need for peace and the need to make decisions and follow through on your convictions.

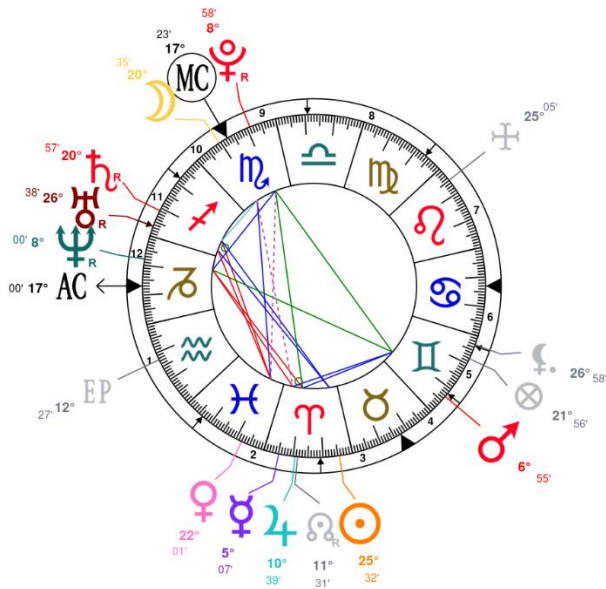
In this context, Uranus plays a revealing role. It forces you to stop cheating yourself in your emotional commitments. It asks you to let go of what is no longer true within you and to dare to form bonds where everyone's truth can breathe, even if this involves upheavals, changes of direction or temporary loneliness.

Emma, your relationship path is rich and demanding. It is not a question of choosing between love and freedom, but of reconciling these two forces within yourself: the need

for a tender, nourishing, living bond and the need to remain true to your deep, free, awakened, ever-changing essence. When you accept that you don't fit into traditional moulds, but instead invent your own unique way of loving, you become capable of experiencing relationships that are as vibrant as they are authentic, where everyone is fully themselves.

Emma, with Jupiter in Pisces in the 10th house, you are driven by an inspired and benevolent vision of your role in the world: your vocation is rooted in a deep intuition, a desire to contribute to something larger, more spiritual or more human. You are destined to succeed not by forcing things, but by letting yourself be guided by what feels right, fluid and aligned. Providence can truly smile on you, provided you know how to recognise the right currents, those subtle movements that push you in the right direction without you having to struggle. But this square to Uranus in Sagittarius in the 7th house can make this process unstable: relationship breakups or upheavals in your partnerships may destabilise you or call certain ambitions into question. You will therefore need to learn to ride the wave without getting lost, to welcome fruitful intuitions without letting yourself be carried away by mirages or unrealistic impulses. This may be your greatest talent: your ability to listen to the signs, to trust your deep sensitivity, while remaining vigilant, clear-headed and able to discern what truly elevates you from what distracts you from yourself.

2) Study of Theo's astrological chart



Theo, your astrological chart highlights a balance between the forces that support you and the challenges that mark your path. Among your strengths are remarkable control over your impulses and an ability to channel them positively in the area of communication, supported by your Sun in Aries in the 3rd house forming a harmonious trine with Saturn and Uranus in Sagittarius. This positioning gives you strategic perseverance and measured boldness, valuable qualities in your quest for personal fulfilment. However, your relationship with money seems to be an area of tension. Venus in Pisces in the 2nd house, under the influence of Neptune in the 12th house, as well

as the Jupiter-Mercury conjunction in Aries in the 2nd house, square Neptune, reveal challenges related to material management and financial illusions. But let's start by highlighting your strength.

Your strength: Mastery and channelling of energies

Your Sun in Aries in the 3rd house, under the structuring influence of Saturn and the innovative inspiration of Uranus in Sagittarius, gives you a balance between impulsiveness and reflection. You have a rare ability to transform your raw energy into concrete actions, thanks to your composure and natural discipline. Your enthusiasm is contagious, while your pragmatism ensures that your efforts find concrete applications.

Your strength: Mastery and channelling of energy in communication

Your Sun in Aries in the 3rd house shines brightly, supported by harmonious trines to Saturn and Uranus in Sagittarius. These influences reinforce your natural ability to structure your thoughts and channel your energy in the field of communication. Saturn, ruler of your Capricorn ascendant, plays a key role in this balance. Positioned in the 11th house, it reflects your ability to find the support you need to achieve your goals, whether through relationships, groups or collectives aligned with your moral or spiritual values. You know how to build strong alliances and invest in networks where mutual support and shared goals enrich your journey.

You thus succeed in transforming sometimes abstract concepts into concrete and coherent actions.

These qualities greatly stabilise your Aries drive. Saturn gives you remarkable composure, tempering your spontaneous impulses and allowing you to approach your interactions with calm and control. In addition, Uranus stimulates your curiosity and openness, encouraging you to explore new ideas and integrate them into your

communication with measured enthusiasm. This continuity in your impulsiveness gives your conversations and projects a lasting impact. Your ability to combine passion and discipline, creativity and structure, makes you an inspired and reliable communicator.

Your ease of expression and agility

Your Mars in Gemini in the 5th house, under the harmonious influence of a sextile to the Jupiter-Mercury conjunction in Aries in the 2nd house, reinforces your natural ease of expression and communication. This positioning makes you a quick-witted and spontaneous person, able to find the right words to charm, convince or simply captivate your audience. Your ability to juggle ideas and adapt your speech to different situations demonstrates great mental and verbal agility. This liveliness, supported by an energetic and curious Mars in Gemini, gives you a natural aptitude for exploring a variety of fields with enthusiasm and versatility.

Your Mars in the 5th house also highlights your taste for creative hobbies, light-hearted and playful interactions, and an ease in incorporating physical expression into your activities. A sport that requires skill or an activity that demands speed and precision would suit you particularly well, as it would take advantage of your agility and natural freedom of movement. You have an innate ability to combine pleasure and efficiency, turning your hobbies into a space for regeneration and personal fulfilment.

Thanks to the sextile between Mars, Jupiter and Mercury, your self-confidence and creativity are amplified. You know how to present yourself with charm and assurance, while using your talents to achieve your goals. This harmonious dynamic between reflection and action allows you to feel at ease in social or competitive contexts, where your quick mind and precise movements become major assets. You thus move through life with an energy that combines intellect with physical expression, making you a complete and inspiring communicator.

Your conflictual relationship with money and material security

Your relationship with money and the material management of your life is a real challenge, marked by complex astral influences. With Venus in Pisces in the 2nd house, square Neptune in Capricorn in the 12th house, and the Jupiter-Mercury conjunction in Aries in the 2nd house also under tension from Neptune, your financial situation is often unstable and lacks clarity. This area is fraught with uncertainty and fluctuations, reflecting a mixture of naivety, idealism and a certain amount of chaos. You may be prone to believing in financial miracles or embarking on adventurous projects without fully assessing the risks.

This configuration reveals a tendency towards impulsive or reckless spending, sometimes dictated by emotions or illusions rather than rational analysis. The square of Neptune may indicate times when you are attracted to dubious propositions or ambiguous financial situations, sometimes to the detriment of your stability. There is a

danger of betrayal, broken promises or manipulation, which can further complicate your relationship with money.

Your Jupiter-Mercury conjunction in Aries in the 2nd house amplifies your material ambition, but this energy can sometimes be misdirected. You are prone to acting quickly or adventurously in your financial choices, which can result in significant gains followed by sudden losses. It is essential to cultivate a more rational and methodical approach, limiting the risks associated with ill-considered investments or spending. Finally, your fertile imagination and creativity could prompt you to seek alternative financial solutions, but it will be crucial to carefully assess their viability and integrity. Increased vigilance and a pragmatic grounding will help you overcome these challenges and build a more stable material foundation.

Your emotional guide and your quest for inner fulfilment

The Moon in Scorpio in the 10th house reflects an intense soul, deeply connected to its inner world, but also focused on external achievement and social recognition. This connection smoothes your relationships with the feminine or intimate world and indicates that you find emotional support in your personal values and creative talents. Venus in Pisces, in its highest expression, enhances your intuitive sensitivity and ability to perceive the needs of others, which can translate into a caring and inspiring role in your professional or public life.

This constellation also highlights a balance between ambition and compassion: you are able to rise in society while remaining true to your emotional needs and your search for authentic connection. However, the emotional intensity of Scorpio and the delicacy of Venus in Pisces remind you to cultivate a solid foundation so that you are not overwhelmed by your feelings or dreams. When you follow this path with discernment, you become an emotional guide for others, capable of inspiring and transforming the environments in which you evolve (this will be particularly strong between September 2025 and May 2026, a period that is also favourable professionally).

Your professional profile, Theo

Your astrological chart reveals a personality that is ambitious, creative and capable of channelling your energies to excel in areas that require communication, intuition and transformation. Your Sun in Aries in the 3rd house, supported by the trines of Saturn and Uranus, shows that you are dynamic and have great control over your impulses. You excel in professions where exchange, teaching or the transmission of ideas play a central role, particularly in environments that encourage continuous learning and innovation.

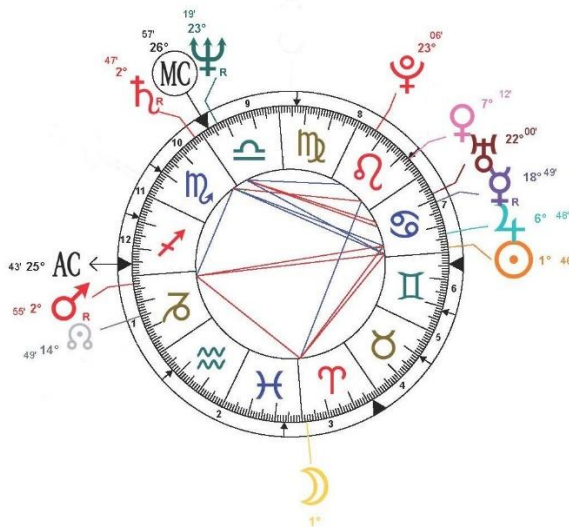
With Mars in Gemini in the 5th house, supported by a sextile to the Jupiter-Mercury conjunction in Aries, you are comfortable in social interactions and creative activities. However, your conflictual relationship with money, marked by tensions between Venus and the Jupiter-Mercury conjunction with Neptune, indicates a challenge to overcome. In your professional life, this could translate into a tendency to make imprudent financial choices, a lack of clarity in project management or excessive sensitivity to illusory promises. To be fully successful, you will need to learn to structure your material ambitions more rationally and surround yourself with sound advice in your economic endeavours.

3) Study of Mathilde's astrological chart



Meeting with sensitivity

The Sun in Cancer in the 7th House illustrates a deep commitment to relationships, seeking to establish a secure and comfortable partnership. This contrasts with the Sagittarius Ascendant, which values freedom and adventure. There is a risk that couple life, if it becomes too homey and predictable, may seem to stifle the Sagittarius Ascendant, limiting their opportunities for growth and exploration. Conversely, excessive commitment to adventure and discovery may leave little room to develop depth and security in relationships, which is essential for the Sun in Cancer.

The key to navigating this dynamic is open and honest communication with your partner. Express your needs for

independence and adventure while acknowledging your desire for security and stability in the relationship. Find a compromise that allows each of you to explore your needs without sacrificing the needs of the other. Incorporate adventure into your relationship by planning trips or activities that stimulate the Sagittarius in you while strengthening your bond. These shared experiences can enrich your relationship and satisfy your need for exploration. Encourage independence within the relationship by giving each other space to pursue personal interests and passions. This allows Sagittarius to explore without feeling restricted, while maintaining the commitment and security that Cancer seeks. View every relationship as fertile ground for personal growth. Work together on personal and spiritual growth goals, which may include studies, workshops, or spiritual retreats. Recognise that the emotional security you build together can be a solid foundation from which to explore the world. This can transform the ‘homebody’ trait into a strength rather than a limitation. Be open to the evolution of your needs and your relationship.

With the Sun in Cancer in the 7th house, your identity and personal fulfilment are closely linked to your relationships and how you care for others. However, the tension aspect with Mars in Capricorn pushes you to react defensively and sometimes aggressively when you feel a threat to yourself or those around you, creating conflict and inner tension between your natural kindness and your eagerness to protect yourself. The conjunction with Jupiter amplifies this dimension, making you more generous and protective, but sometimes to excess, seeking to do too much for those

you love. The tension aspect with the Moon in Aries creates a struggle between your emotional needs and your efforts to nurture and protect others, leading to a feeling of dissatisfaction or neglect of your own needs. Fortunately, the harmonious aspect with Saturn in Scorpio gives you the structure you need to manage these intense dynamics. Your sensitivity is channelled in a thoughtful way, allowing you to build solid and lasting foundations in your relationships, while ensuring a balance between protection and inner serenity. By cultivating a more attentive ear to your own emotions and emphasising your natural rigour, you can combine passion and stability in a way that is beneficial to you and those around you.

The serene, cautious and solitary warrior, the strategist

With Mars in Capricorn in the 1st house, your assertiveness is marked by methodical determination and a desire for lasting success. However, the tense aspects with the Sun, Moon and Jupiter complicate this ambition. The conflict with the Sun causes you to feel intense pressure between your discipline and external expectations, generating frustration and making you feel like you constantly have to prove your worth. The tense aspect with the Moon exacerbates this struggle by creating a disconnect between your hard work and your emotional needs, sometimes leaving you exhausted and unsatisfied. In addition, the tension with Jupiter can lead you to excessive ambition or overly risky projects, making it essential to realign your expectations to avoid disappointment. Fortunately, the harmonious aspect of

Saturn provides a saving counterbalance, allowing you to channel your energy with rigour and perseverance, ensuring the stability and sustainability of your actions. By balancing your determination and remaining attentive to your emotional well-being, you will be able to successfully navigate this complex mix of ambition and sensitivity.

Mars in Capricorn in the 1st House and the Sun in Cancer in the 7th House form a contrast between two powerful energies that express themselves differently. The Sun in Cancer in the 7th House highlights a deep need to engage in intimate and secure relationships, seeking harmony and mutual support. This solar position favours emotion, protection and sensitivity towards others, especially in partnerships. On the other hand, Mars in Capricorn in the 1st House expresses a more solitary and determined approach to life, focused on ambition, discipline and self-control. This Martian position accentuates independence, leadership and the desire to succeed in a concrete and pragmatic way.

This contrast can create internal tension between the desire to collaborate and feel supported in relationships (Sun in Cancer) and the need to assert yourself strongly and autonomously (Mars in Capricorn). You may experience moments when your need for connection and compromise conflicts with your desire to pursue your personal goals in a determined and independent manner. To balance these energies, it is essential to recognise the value of each aspect: use Mars' determination and rigour to support the

Sun's relational goals, and let Cancer's warmth and openness soften and humanise the Martian approach.

A confident, conquering, assertive soul

With the Moon in Aries in the 3rd house, your emotions are intensely influenced by your daily interactions, and you tend to react with spontaneity and passion. The contrast between Mars in Capricorn and the Moon in Aries reveals a tug-of-war between two dynamic energies that are expressed in different ways. This Martian position values rigour, control and perseverance, giving an

On the other hand, the Moon in Aries expresses vivid and immediate emotions, impulsiveness and a need for quick satisfaction. Passionate love

Who am I?

With Sagittarius rising, your quest for identity is built around a desire for exploration, understanding and expansion. 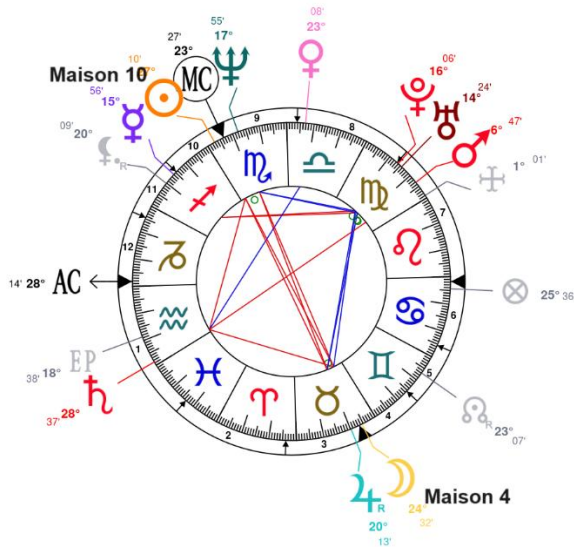

In the professional sphere, these transits could also translate into unexpected opportunities or significant changes in direction, perhaps even a reorientation toward

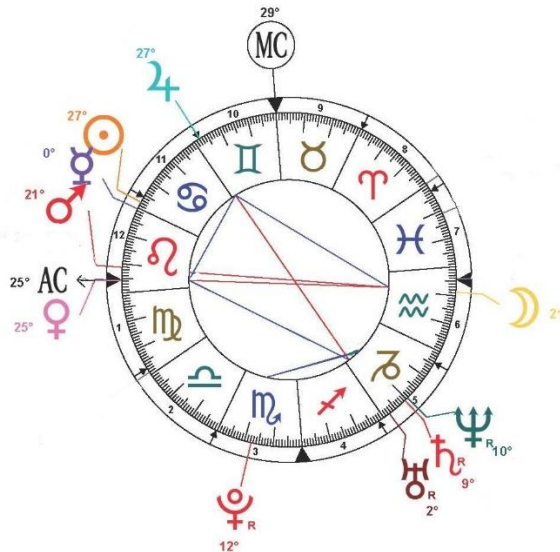
a path that better aligns with your deep ideals and spiritual aspirations, as revealed by Neptune in the tenth house.

5) Study of Pauline's astrological chart

It is a tool for self-understanding which, when used wisely, can shed light on aspects of your personality, reveal underlying dynamics in your life and help you navigate your experiences with greater awareness.

So let's approach your astrological chart not as an unchangeable script for your life, but rather as a resource rich in symbols and meanings that can help you understand your own rhythms, challenges, talents and opportunities for growth.

This study is not a tool to guide your choices, but to make you aware of them. It reveals or confirms your temperament, personality, gifts and talents, your areas of light and shadow.

The first salient feature of your astrological chart is the Ascendant-Mars-Venus-Leo-Moon-Aquarius-7th House axis. The second important feature is the presence of the Sun, ruler of Leo, in Cancer in the 12th house, conjunct Mercury in Leo in the 12th house.

The harmony between your Leo Ascendant (fire sign) and your Sun in Cancer (water sign) in the 12th house is not immediate. **Your Leo Ascendant** gives you this apparent

confidence, this desire for recognition and to shine. There is a natural assurance in you, a luminous energy that can sometimes be perceived as dominant. On the other hand, your **Sun in Cancer in the 12th House** shows a more withdrawn nature, focused on protecting and caring for others, especially those who are vulnerable. There is a gentler, more internal energy focused on caring. It is essential to understand that the energy of your Leo Ascendant and that of your Sun in Cancer in the 12th House operate in different ways. Your most significant challenges and achievements manifest in contexts where you can offer help and understanding to others, often behind the scenes or in a discreet manner. This ascendant ruler in the 12th house indicates that you are guided by a deep need for security and empathy. You are probably very receptive to the emotional needs of others, especially those who are struggling or isolated. This may also mean that your path of personal growth involves discovering your own vulnerability and learning how to transform it into strength by offering support and compassion to others.

Mercury in Leo[1](#)**Conjunct the Sun in Cancer** indicates that your way of thinking and expressing yourself is both creative and thoughtful. You have a quick mind and a natural ability to captivate others with your words. You are able to grasp situations quickly and

synthesise them in a creative and original way, while remaining attentive to the less visible and deeper aspects of these situations. You are gifted with an intelligence that expresses itself with brilliance and enthusiasm, but you are also capable of delving into the depths of the psyche and the invisible. You share your ideas and feelings in an open and warm manner, while remaining sensitive to the emotional needs of others.

It is advisable to use your intellect to address and resolve social problems or to help others express themselves and free themselves from their inhibitions. Your ability to integrate the intellectual currents of your time can enrich your thinking and facilitate the communication of your ideas. Engage in activities that promote personal reflection and freedom of expression, while exploring the spiritual dimensions of existence.

Let's return to your Leo Ascendant, an identity centred on the desire for recognition and recognition. Your Mars in Leo, conjunct with this Ascendant, gives you a powerful presence and an ability to take initiative or carry out actions with passion and confidence. You embody the energy of the proud warrior and leader, acting with nobility to distinguish yourself and express a part of yourself that inspires recognition and admiration. However, there are situations where you may react strongly if you feel unfairly criticised or humiliated. It is important to learn from your actions to refine your understanding of yourself and assert yourself in the world. By asserting yourself with pride, you will fully embrace your uniqueness. However, this requires taking risks to

(If you are too demanding of others, or if you become defensive, or if you react strongly to the slightest conflict with those around you, the **BEECH-FAGUS SYLVATICA** elixir may be helpful. This elixir will allow you to assert your personality while taking into consideration the aspirations of others. It will help you express who you are without attacking others and find your place while being fully aware of the place of others.)

To achieve true autonomy, it is essential to value this need for recognition, while not depending exclusively on external praise. This desire for autonomy is further accentuated by the opposition between **Mars in Leo ↔ Moon in Aquarius**. This opposition creates tension between your quest for identity and your relationship with the public, the people you meet, your partner or business associate. The challenge of this opposition is to find a balance between the need to assert something about yourself^[2] with magnanimity and your unconscious tendency to open up to others with detachment.

With the Moon in Aquarius, your unique, often surprising reactions are mainly guided by a desire for freedom and independence. It is important to note that your soul resists being constrained or possessed.

Before interpreting the meaning of the Moon in the 7th house, I would like to say a few words about the meaning of **Mars in Leo ↔ Moon in Aquarius** on a purely psychological level. This aspect symbolises two opposing forces or tendencies within your psyche: the force of affirmation (symbolised by Mars and often sublimated)

and your femininity (symbolised by the Moon). When you favour one of these two forces over the other, you may find yourself in contrasting situations. On the one hand, by focusing excessively on the well-being of others, you may become very nervous and agitated. In this case, you may be easily upset by adversity and seek protection to avoid facing the world. Futile or irrational concerns can quickly disrupt your endeavours. On the other hand, by opting for unbridled activism, you may reject all forms of tranquillity or healthy well-being. Quiet environments or daily routines may become unbearable, and you may find it difficult to control your aggression, easily losing your temper. This tendency may lead you to engage in multiple daring experiences, at the risk of sacrificing your peace of mind and emotional balance.

(Flower essences for this aspect: RED CHESTNUT-AESCULUS CARNEA, PURPLE IPOMEA-MORNING GLORY-IPOMEA PURPUREA).

Since May 2023, Uranus has been transiting square to this Mars-Moon axis and will continue to do so until May 2024. What has just been said about this axis is particularly relevant. The transit of Uranus forming a square with both Mars in Leo in the 1st house and the Moon in Aquarius in the 7th house can be a significant period of transformation and questioning.

During this transit of Uranus, you may feel a powerful inner urge to free yourself from certain dependencies or constraints that are hindering your progress. This is a call to recognise and admit the need for strategic changes, particularly in the way you assert yourself (Mars in Leo) and manage your relationships (Moon in Aquarius). It is

crucial not to wait until the breaking point to make important decisions. This transit encourages you to approach change with courage and determination. Put aside your fears and doubts, as recognising that change is inevitable can ease the tension and anxiety associated with this period. If you find that the new approaches you have adopted are not working as expected, take the time to analyse the underlying reasons. Don't hesitate to adjust your strategies, keeping in mind another essential aspect of this transit: openness to a more independent, freer and more fulfilling lifestyle. Uranus encourages you to explore less conventional paths that are more authentic to your true self. This transit can be disruptive, but it also holds the potential for significant renewal. By embracing change and being open to new ways of living and expressing yourself, you open the door to refreshing and liberating possibilities. This period can be seen as an opportunity to realign your actions and relationships to more closely reflect who you are and what you truly desire. This Uranus transit will be particularly active during the transits of Mars on the same axis. More specifically, this will occur during the second and third weeks of November 2023, from 10 to 16 March 2024, and the first two weeks of July 2024. You have already experienced this same transit between mid-June and the end of June 2023, and you are currently experiencing it. (flower essences until 16 March 2024: BEECH-FAGUS SYLVATICA, QUAKING GRASS-BRIZA MAXIMA, ALPINE LILY-LILIUM PARVUM, POISON OAK-TOXICODENDRON DIVERSILOBUM.

[1]In astrology, we distinguish between 12 types of intelligence. Mercury in Leo embodies a type of intelligence that can be described as intuitive, creative and

demonstrative. With Mercury in Leo, your intelligence is clear and lucid. You have the ability to quickly understand a situation, synthesise it effectively and draw practical and realistic conclusions. In addition, you have a natural talent for asserting yourself in the realm of ideas. The fire element of the sign of Leo gives Mercury great open-mindedness and remarkable enthusiasm. Mercury in Leo excels at leading conversations or group discussions, thanks to a brilliant intellect and excellent communication skills. This intelligence shines particularly brightly when it is recognised and valued, revealing itself fully when pride is expressed for one's intellectual abilities.

[2] This self-assertion can also be expressed through sports. As a Mars in Leo, you are attracted to physical prowess, outdoor sports, combat sports, extreme sports, and spectacular sports such as urban dance or hip-hop. It is important to set aside time to practise a sport, as this contributes to your personal development. However, be sure to balance this time with moments dedicated to others in order to maintain a healthy balance between your personal needs and your commitment to others.

During the periods from 10 to 16 March 2024 and the first two weeks of July 2024: VITIS VINIFERA, LILIUM MARTAGON, AESCULUS CARNEA, IPOMEA PURPUREA.

Between November 2026 and July 2027, Jupiter and Mars will transit in conjunction with your Mars-Venus conjunction and your Leo Ascendant. This period will mark a significant increase in your attractiveness, charisma and generosity. It will be a productive, active and positive time.

With the Moon in the 7th House, relationships play a prominent role in your life. This lunar position highlights an innate altruism and an instinctive ability to understand other people's feelings. The comfort and security you find in the presence of others are essential to your inner well-being. The quality of your relationships therefore strongly influences your emotional state. In addition, you tend to attract kind people who are attentive to your needs, as suggested by Jupiter^[1] in trine to the Moon. The Moon in the 7th House also indicates a desire to find a partner who offers you emotional support and a certain amount of security. You aspire to a relationship with a deep understanding of feelings, to strengthen your inner balance. But to succeed in a relationship, it is crucial that your partner respects your need for independence and your unavoidable thirst for freedom, especially in your daily life, where routine is unbearable for you. This is why your schedule is constantly enriched by a multitude of encounters. In reality, this is the result of a natural and unconscious reflex that pushes you towards others. Your soul flourishes in total transparency, with a certain detachment. Encounters are formed under the sign of sincerity, where only soul-to-soul communication prevails, giving rise to platonic and idealised relationships. Your days are thus filled with unexpected and unique friendly encounters.

There is another opposition that creates tension between your quest for identity and your relationship with the public, the people you meet, your partner or business associate. This is the opposition between **Venus in Leo in the 1st house and the Moon in Aquarius in the 7th**

house. In this opposition, you are faced with the challenge of finding balance in your love life and relationships.

Your Venus in Leo represents your desire to be loved for who you are as a person, to be admired in order to feel loved, to be admired for your beauty, and to be the centre of attention.[\[2\]](#) You express your feelings in a warm, generous and passionate way, but this can sometimes lean towards a certain self-centredness.[\[3\]](#)

The Moon in Aquarius, on the other hand, directs you towards a need for equality and soul communion with others. You seek to open up to others in a less self-centred approach, more focused on sharing and harmony within your relationships. This lunar position promotes sensitivity to the needs of others and an ability to detach yourself from your ego in order to connect in a more ethereal and spiritual way.

The challenge for you is to find a balance between these two tendencies. How can you flourish emotionally, feel loved and take care of your love life, while remaining open and dedicated to others? It's about combining your need for admiration and personal affection with your aspiration for equal and authentic relationships.

It's important to recognise and honour your desire to be loved and admired, while remaining open to others.

Personal development:

-In astrology, the 12th house is often associated with 'ghosts from the past', a metaphor for memories, traumas,

past experiences, or unconscious behavioural patterns that can profoundly influence a person's present life in subtle ways, often without them being fully aware of it. Mindfulness astrology makes an interesting connection between the theme of 'ghosts of the past' in the 12th house and that of collective currents. When a person does not engage with these collective currents, whether through resistance, ignorance or conditioning, they risk isolating themselves from the community. This may explain why the 12th house is sometimes associated with exile, prison or loneliness. The 'ghosts' in this context represent the unresolved or repressed elements that persist in the psyche. When a person resists or goes against the collective tendency towards dissolution and self-denial in order to merge into a larger whole, these unresolved elements continue to loop. Only when they accept to immerse themselves in these collective currents, to dissolve into something greater than themselves, can these 'ghosts' be confronted and resolved. Meditation can be an effective way to facilitate this process, allowing the person to align themselves with these collective movements and find a place within the community.

The 12th house can also represent behavioural or emotional patterns that are inherited from the past, including childhood, and that manifest in the present in an unconscious way. An important part of working with the 12th house is recognising and releasing these 'ghosts,' which may involve therapy, meditation, personal reflection, or other forms of inner work. This can help break repetitive cycles and heal old wounds.

The 12th house may require confrontation with aspects of oneself that have been rejected or ignored. This may include character traits, desires, or fears that have been suppressed or denied. By working with the energies of the 12th house and confronting these ‘ghosts,’ a person may experience profound spiritual and personal growth, finding peace with their past and gaining a deeper understanding of themselves. The 12th house is therefore often seen as an area where deep inner work can be done to release these hidden influences and move toward greater personal integrity and authenticity.

The Sun in Cancer in the 12th house in your astrological chart may indicate a deep and perhaps hidden or unexpressed connection with family themes. Family issues may play an important role in your inner life, although they may not be visible on the outside. This position may suggest the presence of secrets, unspoken issues or family traumas that have a profound influence on you. There may be aspects of your family history that are hidden, repressed or unresolved. Since the Sun is the ruler of your Leo Ascendant, this heritage may influence how you define your identity. Your stability therefore depends on your awareness of this heritage, on bringing to light aspects of your family history that are hidden, repressed or unresolved, and on turning your back on them once and for all.

Your Sun, ruler of the Leo Ascendant, is conjunct Mercury. You may initially find yourself at odds with or resistant to broader or collective ideas. However, by connecting with these currents, you may begin to let go of inherited, sublimated and self-centred ideas in favour of broader ideas that resonate with the collective unconscious. This harmonisation may lead you to evolve in your way of thinking, guiding you towards a deeper understanding that is more connected with universal themes. This could also involve a transition from self-centred thinking to a more global and altruistic perspective. This approach will also help you feel more stable and define your goals more clearly, which are initially influenced by these ghosts of the past.

-Amidst the multiplicity of encounters (Moon in Aquarius in the 7th house), it is important to make sure you devote time to your personal development. This could include playing a sport, exploring your creative potential, or other activities that nourish your mind and body.

The question also arises of how to reconcile your desire for independence, typical of your Mars in Leo, with your

Cancer-influenced tendency to use your willpower to help and care for others. How can you find a balance between comforting those who are needy or confused and dedicating yourself to noble causes, while preserving your personal space and autonomy? This involves learning to set healthy boundaries and recognising when it is necessary to take a break and recharge your batteries. By taking care of yourself, you will be better equipped to care for others and pursue your commitments with renewed energy and a balanced perspective.

-Given your strong inclination towards relationships, it would be beneficial to hone your communication skills. This could include learning active listening, effective expression of your emotions, and conflict resolution techniques.

-Although you have a natural tendency to care for others, it is equally important to learn how to set boundaries to protect yourself. This may mean learning to say no when necessary, taking time for yourself, and not taking on responsibility for other people's emotions.

-With your strong connection to others, breakups and conflicts can be particularly challenging (Mars opposite the Moon in the 7th house). Learning stress management techniques and strengthening your emotional resilience could be very helpful in dealing with these delicate situations.

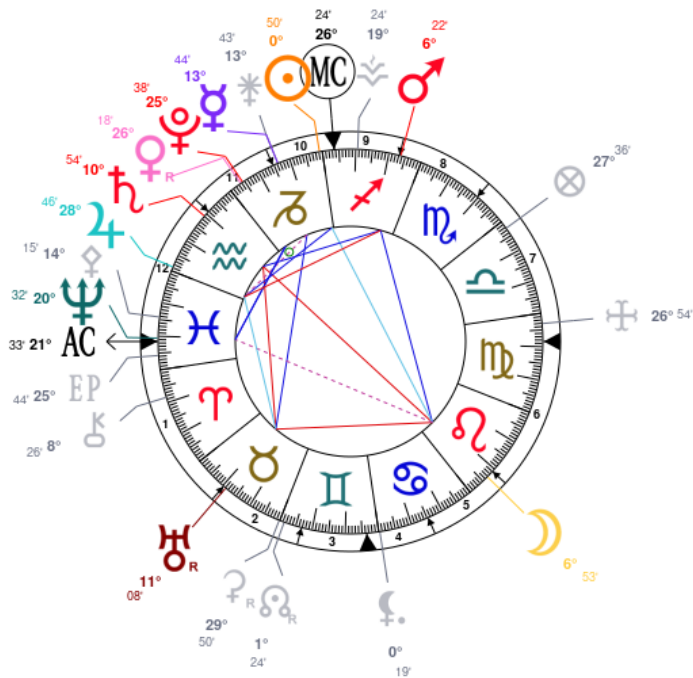

In your case, you are physically attracted to a man whose characteristics are marked by the sign of Leo, and you would like to consider a long-term relationship with him if he also has characteristics of the sign of Cancer.

6) Study of a child's astrological chart



Justine's natal chart reveals a young soul driven by a deep alliance between intuition and determination, between dreams and structure. Her Pisces Ascendant, conjunct Neptune, gives her a gentle, fluid, often elusive presence and great emotional permeability. She will pick up on atmospheres and sense others without the need for words, and from an early age will have a natural connection to the invisible, the imaginary and the inner world. Justine may sometimes seem absent or withdrawn, but in reality she will be absorbing the subtleties of the world around her with extraordinary finesse.

And yet, mirroring this floating sensitivity, the Sun in Capricorn in the 10th House will anchor her in a quest for solid, structured achievement, focused on social recognition. She will have a powerful need to fulfil herself, to leave a mark, to build something lasting. This Sun indicates an early vocation, an ability to set clear goals and pursue them with patience and rigour. Contrary to what one might think when seeing her Pisces Ascendant, Justine will not be unstable or scattered: she will be sensitive, certainly, but also ambitious, focused and determined.

This dialogue between the Pisces Ascendant and the Sun in Capricorn in the 10th House will be a real asset: on the one hand, a strategic, realistic and deeply embodied vision, and on the other, a keen intuition and emotional instinct that will help her sense the right moment, the right person and the right opportunity. You can support her by nurturing her natural confidence while respecting her moments of withdrawal. She will need space to dream, but also solid structures to build on. A proud, loyal soul

Justine's natal chart reveals an inner life that is intense, proud, sensitive and often tense. Her Moon in Leo in the 6th House illuminates her daily life with a deep need for human warmth, recognition and generous self-expression. In the sphere of work or habits, Justine will naturally seek to serve with heart, to beautify her environment, to create a lively, joyful, almost theatrical atmosphere around her, where everyone will be seen and recognised for their value. It will be very important for her to feel useful but also admired, whether in small tasks or in her future commitments.

But this beautiful lunar flame will be under pressure, as Saturn in Aquarius in the 12th House will oppose it head-on. There will be a wound of non-recognition here, as if what Justine offers from her inner light will not always find an immediate echo in the outside world. She may feel, right now, a certain emotional loneliness, a difficulty in freely expressing her feelings, or a feeling of being judged when she simply wants to shine. Over the years, if Justine learns to root herself in her own inner loyalty and to honour her truth even when it is not seen, she will be able to transform this lunar configuration into immense emotional and human wealth. A source of lasting, free and deeply creative radiance.

A child who loves freedom

Justine has an inner strength that is enthusiastic, noble and surprisingly stable, as evidenced by Mars in Sagittarius in the 9th house, trine to her Moon in Leo in the 6th house and sextile to Saturn in Aquarius in the 12th house.

This Mars in Sagittarius indicates a child who loves freedom and is driven by a vital need to understand the world. She will move courageously towards the unknown, eager for truth, wide open spaces, and philosophical or cultural discoveries. Her energy will not be scattered, but directed towards expanding her consciousness. She may show an early appetite for intellectual adventure, a

willingness to defend her ideas, to go ‘further’ and ‘higher’, always with a frank enthusiasm and a natural faith in life.

This placement also suggests a keen sense of justice: Justine does not remain silent if she perceives an injustice. She may feel the need to fight for a cause, to give a higher meaning to her actions. Her inner drive will not be conquest for conquest's sake, but integrity and the quest for meaning.

However, this Mars is harmonised by the Moon. The Moon-Mars trine offers a beautiful fluidity between emotions and actions. She knows how to act on her feelings and mobilise herself without losing touch with who she is. This synergy gives her an instinctive understanding of situations: she will sense when to act and how to defend what is important to her, without unnecessary violence, with tact, warmth and natural authority. Her energy is emotional, loyal, generous, capable of mobilising others with the fervour of her heart.

But that's not all: the sextile to Saturn adds a layer of stability, discernment and rigour to this lively energy. Here, Mars does not get carried away. It will structure itself over time, learn to plan, channel its enthusiasm and make its ideals sustainable. This link to Saturn in the 12th House is subtle: it speaks of a quiet, inner strength that Justine will be able to cultivate over the years. But this Mercury does not live in isolation: it is in the 11th house, which opens it up to collective, friendly and societal perspectives. Justine doesn't just think for herself, but also for the world. As she grows up, she may feel drawn to group projects, common causes, or ideas aimed at improving the future. Her structured thinking could be put to use in the service of a collective ideal, particularly in areas where intellectual rigour is necessary for social or human innovation.

The Uranus trine electrifies, refines and powerfully stimulates her intelligence. This harmonious link between Mercury and Uranus, both in Earth signs, suggests an ability to combine tradition and innovation. Justine could develop a way of thinking that is both pragmatic and original, capable of questioning certain preconceived ideas while giving them concrete and applicable form.

This trine also promotes quick, intuitive thinking that is connected to the major trends of her time. She has a clear, penetrating gaze that is sometimes ahead of her age. Later in life, this could translate into original ideas, a taste for technology, systems or smart networks, as well as an ease in perceiving connections between things. She could be gifted with remarkable discernment in communication,

with an ability to enlighten others with her sober but powerful words.

The fact that Uranus is in the 3rd house, the house of fundamental learning, reinforces this impression that, as she grows up, she could reinterpret what she has learned in a very personal way, even anticipating certain collective movements before they fully emerge.

A serious, reserved and loyal emotional nature

The conjunction of Venus and Pluto in Capricorn in the 11th house in Justine's chart suggests that as she grows up, your daughter will develop a deep, demanding and inwardly powerful way of loving and bonding with others.

With Venus in Capricorn, we see a serious, reserved and loyal emotional nature emerging. Justine will not open her heart easily; she will prefer to build her relationships slowly, in an atmosphere of trust and stability. She will value commitment, reliability and loyalty in her friendships and, later, in her romantic relationships. You will notice that she prefers environments where the rules are clear, commitments are kept, and intentions are sincere.

But this Venus is not alone. It is conjunct Pluto, the planet of transformation, intensity and lucidity. Justine is likely to experience her attachments with great inner intensity, as if each important relationship engages an essential part of her being.

In light of your daughter Justine's astrological chart, a rich, complex and unique professional profile emerges, reflecting the deep energies that inhabit her. Her Sun in Capricorn in the 10th house, under a protective sextile from Jupiter, indicates from childhood an aspiration to accomplish something solid, useful and structuring in the world. Justine will seek fulfilment through a position of responsibility, in an environment where she can feel useful, respected and invested in a long-term mission. She will not choose her career lightly: she will strive for efficiency, recognition and contribution to a larger order.

But this Capricorn vocation will be tempered, enriched and softened by a Pisces Ascendant conjunct Neptune, which will give Justine an empathetic, imaginative and deeply inspired dimension. While Capricorn draws a clear line to the top, Pisces will remind her that the heart, dreams and collective meaning are just as important. Her Moon in Leo in the 6th house, under multiple aspects, shows that Justine will need to feel useful in her daily life, while also feeling that she is shining and contributing something unique. Finally, her Venus conjunct Pluto in Capricorn in the 11th house gives her a rare ability to invest emotionally in

2. Educator or director of an educational or social institution, where her inner strength and kindness would work wonders.
3. Accountant, accounting manager or management teacher, where her intellectual rigour and ability to communicate would flourish.
4. Oceanographer, naval architect, water quality or marine resource manager, thanks to the link between Neptune, Pisces and Capricorn, which speaks of exploration, measurement, connection to the sea and scientific structuring.
5. Immunologist, marine geologist, or seismologist, for the rigorous scientific dimension of Capricorn, mixed with the intuition of Pisces and the piercing gaze of Pluto.
6. Airport security officer, customs office supervisor, or trainer in a specialised school, professions where her seriousness, vigilance, and sense of

responsibility can be put to work for the common good.

7. Humanitarian aid worker, combining her need for practical action with a broader ideal of service, particularly in multicultural contexts or crisis situations.
8. As a museum curator or heritage manager, the Moon in Leo likes to highlight beauty, memory and creation, while Mars in Sagittarius opens her up to great civilisations and human history. Capricorn gives her patience, rigour and a taste for preservation. She could flourish in a role combining culture, transmission and organisation.
9. As a musician or composer with a committed or therapeutic approach, Pisces Ascendant conjunct Neptune, combined with the Moon in Leo, shows potential for sensitive, embodied, and radiant artistic expression. This will not necessarily be her main activity, but she could engage in it wholeheartedly in a therapeutic, social, or spiritual setting. She could use music as a medium for healing or transmitting values.
1. As an urban planner or territorial planner, the Sun, Mercury, Venus and Pluto in Capricorn give her a strategic and structuring mind, focused on the organisation of space and time. The 11th House (communities) could steer her towards urban development or sustainable land management projects. She would have the ability to think about people in their environment, with a sense of responsibility on a large scale.

Over the years, it will be valuable to offer her a framework that is both structured and open, where she can explore these different dimensions of herself: the need for security and direction (Capricorn), the call of dreams and connection (Pisces), the pride of serving and shining (Leo), and the drive for knowledge and the world (Sagittarius).
