# **Workshop 4 Astrology and careers**

The study of an astrological chart or birth chart sheds light on the areas that inspire us and points us in a direction. It highlights the areas of social and/or professional activity in which we are most predisposed and where we are most likely to flourish.

Every profession, especially if it is highly specialised, has its own psychological profile. This book establishes a correlation between a person's astrological chart and the professions that are most suited to them.

Each planet in the solar system is associated with certain specific aptitudes: the Moon with receptivity, the Sun with willpower and exemplary behaviour; Mercury with curiosity and communication; Venus with emotionality and aesthetic sense; Mars with combativeness and dynamism; Jupiter with organisational skills; Saturn with rigour and patience; Uranus with innovation and discovery; Neptune with intuition and premonition; Pluto with research and investigation.

The sun sign at birth is the main indicator and provides general guidance. It symbolises the energy field used to develop our personal charisma, make choices and fulfil our destiny. The path to our fulfilment lies in the energies of the sign occupied by the sun. It is our inner guide, our life force and indicates where we are heading.

Depending on each direction indicated by our sun sign, our professional profile becomes clearer when we take into account the other dominant signs in our astrological chart.

First, you need to determine the dominant signs in your astrological chart. To do this, fill in the table below. It takes into account the following principle in astrology: the more planets there are in a sign, the more important that sign is and the more it needs to be taken into account when determining your professional profile.

In this table, each planet (and the ascendant) is assigned a certain number of points. The ascendant sign is one of the most important signs in an astrological chart, which is why we assign it 5 points.

For the planets, we apply the following principle: the faster they move, the more important they are in a birth chart. We assign 3 points to the Moon, then 2 points to Mercury, Venus and Mars, which are slower, and 1 point to the slow planets, Jupiter and Saturn.

Next, refer to the chapter corresponding to your sun sign and note the professions associated with one or two of your dominant signs. These are probably the most suitable for you or may provide you with avenues for further research.

## **Important notes:**

-If one or more planets in your astrological chart are in the 6th house, refer to chapter 4. This chapter provides guidance on the challenges you may face in the workplace or in relation to your colleagues, superiors or employees.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> If you have knowledge of astrology, you can refine these results as follows: add 2 points to the sign if its ruler is close to the Ascendant, 2 points to the sign if its ruler is close to the Midheaven (MC), 2 points to the sign if its ruler is close to the ruler of the Ascendant, 1 point to the sign if its ruler is in aspect with one or more planets, 1 point to the sign if the house in affinity with this sign is occupied by one or more planets.

-If one or more planets in your birth chart are in the 10th house, refer to chapter 3. This chapter provides advice on how to succeed, climb the career ladder or meet society's expectations.

-If planets are in aspect in your astrological chart, refer to chapter 5. There you will find advice on how to overcome conflicts that could hinder your success.

# Progression method for each course

Here are a few guidelines to help you progress:

### No rote learning

No content needs to be memorised mechanically. The aim is not to acquire encyclopaedic knowledge, but to allow a living understanding of each symbol to mature within you. The lessons and associated readings are **tools for awakening**, not fixed knowledge. Let them sink in.

### A practice-based approach

The astrology taught here is a path of practice, not abstract knowledge. For each element covered (planet, sign, house, aspect, etc.), it is strongly recommended that you observe actual charts. This may include:

- · Your own birth chart
- · Those of your loved ones (family, friends)
- · Public figures (artists, writers, politicians, etc.) whose charts are available online
